5. Essays are judged on content and grammar style. Proofread and spell check for accuracy.
6. Give yourself enough time to request all of the necessary materials especially letters of recommendation. They play an important role and should be informative and speak to your qualifications and character. Brief and uninformative recommendations do not weigh well in the judging process.

 - a. A Professor, Guidance Counselor, Minister or Community Leader who can attest to your community service, leadership or academic standing
 - b. Your Amicae Auxiliary Sponsor or an elected officer of the Sponsoring Chapter
