

- 1. Contact the Scholarship Chair, if a problem arises.

- 2. Scholarship awards amounts are at the discretion of the Scholarship committee.
- 3. Review the entire application before completing it. If a field is left blank it will count against you. *If you do not want to answer a question, put an explanation in the field.*
- 4. Submit all information together and on time.
- 5. Each application is judged on its own merit, so include any information that makes you exceptional and a good candidate to receive the award. Incomplete and unprofessional applications are unacceptable.
- 6. Essays are judged on content and grammar style. Proofread and spell check for accuracy. Points are deducted for poor grammar.
- 7. Give yourself enough time to request all of the necessary materials especially letters of recommendation. They play an important role and should be informative and speak to your academic standing and financial situation. Brief and uninformative recommendations do not weigh well in the judging process.
- 8. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Tau Psi Zeta Chapter reserves the right to use the scholarship recipient's name and information for the Sorority's publicity and advertising of this scholarship.
- 9. Scholarships will be awarded in the Fall of the application year after enrollment is verified.
